6. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT: BY RON HAMILTON

Ron Hamilton will report on activities and/or issues relevant to the sound management of the school as well as achievements and accomplishments of students and staff.

Mr. Hamilton reported current enrollment numbers: Country School-172, High School-48, Independent Study-199, for a total of 419.

The drive-thru dinner fundraiser was a great success with over 200 tri-tips sold. The funds raised will go towards field trips.

The High School and Independent Study Open House was March 2nd. There was an excellent turn out with students from local elementary schools wanting to learn about the programs.

Our current enrollment for next year stands at 202. Last year at this time we were at 119. Enrollment is mainly for the on-campus programs. Independent Study tends to be the last program to fill.

Our High School science teacher, Dan Webster, and Liz Jones, head of curriculum, attended the County's training to begin the selection process of the NGSS curriculum. On March 24th we will have a staff development for all teachers to begin training them on these new Science state standards.

Our 4th and 5th graders just completed the SHIPS trip in San Francisco. This overnight trip allowed the students to run an 1849 era Clipper ship. Grades 6-8 will attend Science camp

next week at Alliance Redwoods.

Mr. Hamilton reported changes from the 1st interim budget. The 1st interim budget was based off of 395 students; the 2nd interim budget is based off of 410. Revenues have gone from 3.3 million to 3.5 million.
